

CHAPTER 65

AN ACT to create 62.23 (7) (da) of the statutes, relating to interim zoning.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

62.23 (7) (da) of the statutes is created to read:

62.23 (7) (da) *Interim zoning.* The common council of any city which has not adopted a zoning ordinance may, without referring the matter to the plan commission, enact an interim zoning ordinance to preserve existing uses while the comprehensive zoning plan is being prepared. Such ordinance may be enacted as is an ordinary ordinance but shall be effective for no longer than 2 years after its enactment.
