CHAPTER 673

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 110.07 (3) of the statutes, relating to limited enforcement powers for motor vehicle inspectors.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

110.07 (3) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

110.07 (3) The commissioner of motor vehicles may employ not to exceed 70 nonuniformed inspectors whose duties shall be to enforce and assist in administering s. 110.10 (11) and chs. 340 to 345 and chs. 347 to 349 of the motor vehicle code and chs. 129 and 194. Such inspectors, in the performance of these duties, shall have the powers and authority of state traffic officers. Inspectors shall not enforce ch. 346 relating to the rules of the road. For the purpose of death, disability and retirement coverage, such inspectors shall be subject to ss. 66.191, 66.90 to 66.918 in the same manner as members of the state traffic patrol.
