**CHAPTER 693**

AN ACT to amend 253.29 (2) (a) of the statutes, relating to filing fees at the time of filing inventories in estates of deceased persons.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

253.29 (2) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

253.29 (2) (a) For filing a petition whereby any proceeding in estates of deceased persons is commenced, when the gross estate or value

of the property is \$1,000 or less, no fee; when the gross estate is more than \$1,000 and less than \$10,000, a fee of \$3; when the gross estate is \$10,000 or more and less than \$25,000, a fee of \$6; when the gross estate is \$25,000 or more and less than \$100,000, a fee of \$25; when the gross estate is \$100,000 or more, a fee of \$100. Such fees shall be paid \* \* \* at the time of the filing of the inventory, or other documents, setting forth the value of the estate in such proceedings. The fees fixed in this subsection shall also be paid in survivorship proceedings and in such survivorship proceedings the value shall be based on the value of the property passing to the survivor or survivors.
