CHAPTER 698

AN ACT to repeal 50.07 (3) ; to amend chapter 526, laws of 1957, section 27, 50.03 (2), as repealed and recreated by chapter 526, laws of 1957, 50.04 (7) (intro. par.), as created by chapter 526, laws of 1957, and 58.06 (2), as amended by chapter 526, laws of 1957, of the statutes, relating to the clarification of the provisions concerned with the organization and operation of the institutions for the care of the tubercular.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 50.03 (2) of the statutes, as repealed and recreated by chapter 526, laws of 1957, is amended to read:

50.03 (2) There may also be admitted for care and treatment upon proper certificate of examining physician and recommendation of the * * * *director of the state department of public welfare any minor committed to the department or to the institutions under its supervision. The department is authorized to make such transfers.*

SECTION 1m. 50.04 (7) (intro. par.) of the statutes, as created by chapter 526, laws of 1957, is amended to read:

50.04 (7) (intro. par.) Each county maintaining in whole or in part a tuberculosis sanatorium shall be credited by the state, to be adjusted as provided in s. 50.09, for each patient cared for therein at public charge *in the 1957-58 fiscal year and subsequent fiscal years, as follows:*

SECTION 2. 50.07 (3) (intro. par.), (a) and (b), as amended by chapter 526, laws of 1957, and 50.07 (3) (c) of the statutes are repealed effective as of December 31, 1957.

SECTION 3. 58.06 (2) of the statutes, as amended by chapter 526, laws of 1957, is amended to read:

58.06 (2) Any private, philanthropic tuberculosis sanatorium organized on a nonprofit basis, if approved by the state board of health, may admit patients committed to it by any county, *or transferred to it by the state department of public welfare, in the manner and upon the terms provided by * * * ss. 50.03 and 50.04 except that if the amount charged such patients is more than the actual per capita cost as determined under s. 50.04 they shall not be entitled to state aid.*

SECTION 4. Chapter 526, laws of 1957, SECTION 27, is amended to read:

(Chapter 526, laws of 1957) SECTION 27. SECTIONS 1, 2 and 3 of this act shall be effective July 1, 1957. *SECTION 3m shall be effective as of October 1, 1957. SECTIONS 12 and 17 shall be effective July 1, 1958.* SECTION 13 shall be effective upon passage and publication. All other sections shall be effective on December 31, 1957.

SECTION 5. SECTIONS 1, 1m and 3 of this act shall take effect December 31, 1957.

SECTION 6. Each county shall be credited under s. 50.04 (7) for the fiscal year 1956-57 and prior years at the rate established in s. 50.07 (3) (a) of the 1955 statutes.
