CHAPTER 8

AN ACT to create 20.005 (2) (a) (line 431a), 20.500 (41) and 24.39 (3) of the statutes, relating to the transfer of certain moneys received for the leasing of land and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.005 (2) (a) (line 431a) of the statutes is created to read:

SECTION 2. 20.500 (41) of the statutes is created to read:
20.500 (41) LEASED LAND RECEIPTS. All moneys received by the commissioners from the United States government, on account of leasing

land under the U. S. flood control act of 1954 and subsequent amendments thereto, are appropriated to the commissioners to be paid out as provided in s. 24.39 (3).

SECTION 3. 24.39 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

24.39 (3) All moneys received by the commissioners from the leasing of land under the U. S. flood control act of 1954 and subsequent amendments thereto, shall be paid into the general fund of the state within one week and are appropriated therefrom to the commissioners to be paid to the county clerk of the county in which the leased land is located for the benefit of the general fund of such county within 30 days of its receipt by the commissioners.
