CHAPTER 89

AN ACT to amend 88.19 (2) of the statutes, relating to hearings on reports of farm drainage boards.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

88.19 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

88.19 (2) Upon the filing of the report the court shall, by its written order, fix a time and place of hearing thereon. The notice of hearing shall * * * specify the amount proposed to be assessed against the land of each owner, *as shown by the last tax roll*, and the time and place of hearing. Copies of the notice shall be * * * *sent to each owner, as shown by the last tax roll, by mail at least 10 days before the hearing but if any assessment is proposed, by certified mail.* The court shall hear all interested parties at the hearing and shall then examine and may amend or modify the report and when the same * * * *is made satisfactory*, the court shall approve the same and the board shall thereupon apportion the assessment against the lands and corporations benefited.
