**CHAPTER 167**

AN ACT to create 255.04 (2) (c) of the statutes, relating to the furnishing of names to the sheriff by the jury commission for special jury service.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

255.04 (2) (c) of the statutes is created to read:

255.04 (2) (c) The commissioners shall also furnish upon periodic request of the sheriff a current list of the names of persons available for jury duty in justice of the peace court, mental inquiries and re-examinations, coroner's inquests, and for such other purposes as the sheriff is required by law to summon or select a jury, which list shall contain not less than 100 nor more than 200 names of persons drawn and apportioned in the manner provided in par. (a).
