**CHAPTER 190**

AN ACT to amend 236.21 (1) (b) of the statutes, relating to metes and bounds descriptions in surveyors certificates on plats entitling the plats to be recorded.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

236.21 (1) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

236.21 (1) (b) A clear and concise description of the land surveyed, divided and mapped by government lot, quarter-quarter section, section,

township, range and county; *and by metes and bounds commencing with some corner marked and established by the U.S. public land survey;* or if such land is located in a municipality or subdivision or addition thereto, then by the number or other description of the lot, block or \* \* \* subdivision thereof, \* \* \* *which has previously been tied to a corner marked and established in the U.S. public land survey. \* \* \**
