CHAPTER 28

AN ACT to amend 29.22 (2) of the statutes, relating to color of clothing for hunters.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

29.22 (2) of the statutes are amended to read:

29.22 (2) In the areas in which there is a season for the hunting of deer with fire arms, no person shall hunt during such season unless at least 50 per cent of the visible portion of his hunting cap and at least 50 per cent of his jacket, excluding the sleeves, shall be red \* \* \*, orange, or *bright yellow* or covered with a handkerchief or cloth of *bright red* \* \* \*, *bright orange* or *bright yellow* color. Any person violating this subsection shall upon conviction be \* \* \* fined \$10.
