**CHAPTER 369**

**AN ACT to amend 247.20 and 247.39; and to create 247.06 (3) of the statutes, relating to divorce.**

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 247.06 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

247.06 (3) In every action for divorce from bed and board and from the bonds of matrimony the complaint must set forth the ages and residences of both parties and, if either party was previously divorced, the name of the court in which the divorce was granted and the time and place the divorce was granted.

SECTION 2. 247.20 of the statutes is amended to read:

247.20 The court, upon granting a divorce from the bonds of matrimony, may allow the wife to resume her maiden name or the name of a former deceased husband, *or the name of a husband of a former marriage of which there are children in her custody*, in case there be no children of the *current* marriage.

SECTION 3. 247.39 of the statutes is amended to read:

247.39 If any persons, after being divorced from the bond of matrimony for any cause whatever, shall cohabit together before intermarriage they shall be liable to \* \* \* *punishment as for a criminal contempt subject to and in accordance with the applicable provisions of ss. 256.03 to 256.07.*
