CHAPTER 37

AN ACT to amend 29.48 (1) ; and to create 29.45 (4), 29.55 (3) and (4) of the statutes, relating to free deer farm licenses for public zoos.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 29.45 (4) of the statutes is created to read:

29.45 (4) No bona fide public zoo shall be subject to this section.

SECTION 2. 29.48 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

29.48 (1) Except as provided by * * * ss. 29.52 and 29.55 (3), no person shall at any time sell, purchase or barter, or offer to sell, purchase or barter, or have in possession or under control for the purpose of sale or barter any deer, squirrel, game bird, game fish taken from inland waters, or the carcass or part thereof, nor any other wild animal, or carcass or part thereof, during the close season therefor. This section applies, whether such animals were lawfully or unlawfully taken within or without the state.

SECTION 3. 29.55 (3) and (4) of the statutes are created to read:

29.55 (3) No bona fide public zoo shall be subject to this section.

(4) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary it is lawful for a bona fide public zoo to have, purchase, barter or sell any live animal, domestic or foreign, to or with another bona fide public zoo, licensed deer farm or reputable animal dealer, within or without this state.
