CHAPTER 428

AN ACT to amend chapter 164, laws of 1951, sections 6 and 7, relating to calling in a judge and appeals from the county court of Marathon county.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Chapter 164, laws of 1951, sections 6 and 7 are amended to read:

(Chapter 164, laws of 1951) Section 6. In case the presiding judge of said county court shall, on account of sickness, absence from the county or disqualification for any cause, *including by affidavit of prejudice*, be disabled from presiding in the trial of any action or proceeding aforesaid, he shall, in writing, designate a \* \* \* *judge of any court of record of this state* to preside and hold court in his stead, and such \* \* \* *judge* shall thereupon in said action or proceeding possess and exercise all of the powers given by this act to the county judge of Marathon county. \* \* \*

SECTION 7. All appeals from judgments of said county court, excepting in actions for divorce and to annul any marriage, shall be made to the circuit court of Marathon county, \* \* \* and all the laws relating to appeals from justice court shall apply thereto \* \* \*.
