CHAPTER 430

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 348.05 (3) of the statutes, relating to moving overwidth farm machinery on highways.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

348.05 (3) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

348.05 (3) OVERWIDTH FARM MACHINERY. Notwithstanding any provision of this section to the contrary farm tractors exceeding 9 feet in width and all other farm machinery and implements of husbandry exceeding 8 feet in width may be moved, towed, hauled, by truck or trailer, or in any other manner or by any other means, over the highways of this state by dealers or for purposes of repair without special permit between the hours of 7 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Mondays through Thursdays and from 7 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. on Fridays. Such overwidth machinery shall not be moved on any Wisconsin highway which is part of the national system of interstate highways without special permit.
