CHAPTER 52

AN ACT to amend 343.01 (2) (e) (intro. par.) of the statutes, relating to the definition of a chauffeur for purposes of operating a motor vehicle.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

343.01 (2) (e) (intro. par.) of the statutes is amended to read:

343.01 (2) (e) (intro. par.) "Chauffeur" means every person, including the vehicle owner, who is employed for the principal purpose of operating a motor vehicle *or when one of the principal duties is the operation of a truck for a major portion of his full working week*, and every person who operates a motor vehicle while in use as a public carrier of persons or property for hire, except that a person is not a chauffeur within the meaning of this paragraph solely because:
