

CHAPTER 536

AN ACT to create 66.186 of the statutes, relating to self-insurance for health of employes of cities of the first class.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.186 of the statutes is created to read:

66.186 HEALTH INSURANCE; CITIES OF THE FIRST CLASS.
The common council of any city of the first class may, by ordinance or resolution, provide for general hospital, surgical and group insurance for city officers and city employes and their respective dependents and for payment of premiums therefor in private companies. Appropriations may be made for the purpose of financing such insurance. Moneys accruing to such fund, by investment or otherwise, shall not be diverted for any other purpose than those for which such fund was set up or to defray management expenses of such fund or to partially pay premiums so as to reduce costs to the city or to persons covered by such insurance, or both.
