#### CHAPTER 591

AN ACT to amend 126.48 (2); and to create 126.48 (3) of the statutes, relating to certifications of grades and analyses of the chief inspector for the warehouse commission and evidence of facts therein.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 126.48 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

126.48 (2) The chief \* \* \* *inspector* may issue certificates under his hand and the seal of the state, showing in detail the results of \* \* \* *the chief chemist's* analyses \* \* \*, *who* shall keep a correct record in detail of all samples of grain and cereal products and the analyses thereof, which certificates are prima facie evidence of the facts therein contained.

SECTION 2. 126.48 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

126.48 (3) The chief inspector may issue under his hand and the seal of the state a sanitation certificate of the condition of all holds and compartments of a vessel examined and found to be free of live weevil or insects injurious to stored grain and free of objectionable odors, the date and time, the name of the vessel examined and the signature of the examiner. Such certificate is prima facie evidence of the facts therein contained.
