**CHAPTER 630**

AN ACT to amend 348.05 (2) (e); and to create 348.05 (2) (k) of the statutes, relating to the transportation of tie logs under 9 feet in length on the public highways.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 348.05 (2) (e) of the statutes is amended to read:

348.05 (2) (e) 8 feet 6 inches for loads of \* \* \* pulpwood slabs and unplaned dimension material cut therefrom;

SECTION 2. 348.05 (2) (k) of the statutes is created to read:

348.05 (2) (k) 9 feet for loads of tie logs and tie slabs, provided that no part of the load shall extend more than 6 inches beyond the fender line on the left side of the vehicle or extend more than 10 inches beyond the fender line on the right side of the vehicle. The term fender line as used herein means as defined in s. 348.09. This paragraph shall not be applicable to transport on highways designated as parts of the national system of interstate and defense highways pursuant to s. 84.29. The exemptions provided by this paragraph shall apply only to single and tandem axle trucks.
