**CHAPTER 110**

AN ACT to amend 57.07 (1) and 959.045 (1) of the statutes, relating to sentence, commitment and parole.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 57.07 (1) of the statutes is amended to read :

57.07 (1) The department may parole prisoners in the state reformatory and the home for women whenever suitable employment has been

secured for them, unless otherwise provided by the department, and their conduct for a reasonable time has satisfied the department that they will be law-abiding, temperate, honest and industrious. But \* \* \* *persons* serving life sentences \* \* \* shall be subject to the provisions of s. 57.06.

SECTION 2. 959.045 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

959.045 (1) Male persons not less than 16 nor more than 30 years of age may be sentenced to the Wisconsin state reformatory if convicted of a felony \* \* \* or a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment in the county jail or house of correction for one year or more.
