CHAPTER 137

AN ACT relating to authorizing the judge of branch No. 2 of the fourteenth judicial circuit to appoint as reporter for his branch the person who is reporter for the municipal court of Brown county, civil court branch on December 31, 1961.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

In branch No. 2 of the fourteenth judicial circuit, the circuit judge may appoint a reporter for said branch when it becomes operative under chapter 315, laws of 1959. The reporter serving in the municipal court of Brown

county, civil court branch, on December 31, 1961, shall be given the first appointment, shall retain his civil service status and shall be paid by the county the same total salary as is received by the reporter of branch No. 1 of said fourteenth judicial circuit, provided that the state shall reimburse Brown county annually on voucher signed by the circuit judge of said branch No. 2, for that portion of said reporter's salary which is paid by the state to the reporter of branch No. 1 of said fourteenth judicial circuit. Whenever the service of the reporter first appointed as hereinabove provided is terminated, his successor shall be appointed and paid in the same manner as the reporter in the first branch of said circuit, as provided in section 252.18 (1) of the statutes.
