

CHAPTER 146

AN ACT to create 15.94 (6a) and 20.275 (70) of the statutes, relating to the procedure for handling claims against the state involving less than \$500.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 15.94 (6a) of the statutes is created to read:

15.94 (6a) SETTLEMENT OF CLAIMS COMMISSION. Whenever the claims commission by unanimous vote finds that a claim for less than \$500 is justified, it may order such claim paid on its own motion without submission of the claim in bill form to the legislature. Such claims shall be paid upon the certification of the chairman and secretary, from the appropriation made by s. 20.275 (1) or (70).

SECTION 2. 20.275 (70) of the statutes is created to read.

20.275 (70) There is appropriated from the conservation fund and the highway fund to the claims commission a sum sufficient to carry out the functions required by s. 15.94.

SECTION 3. This bill is declared to be an emergency executive budget bill in accordance with the provisions of 16.47 (2).
