**CHAPTER 15**

AN ACT to amend 37.11 (2), (3) and (10) of the statutes, relating to the official designation of the administrative head of a state college.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 37.11 (2), (3) and (10) of the statutes are amended to read:

37.11 (2) To appoint a \* \* \* *president* and assistants and such other teachers and officers and to employ such persons as may be required for each of said colleges; and to prescribe their several duties.

(3) To remove at pleasure any \* \* \* *president*, assistant or other officer or person from any office or employment in connection with any such college, but discharges of teachers shall be governed by \* \* \* s. 37.31.

(10) To confer by bylaws upon the \* \* \* *presidents* of the several state colleges the power to suspend or expel pupils for misconduct or other cause prescribed in such bylaws.

SECTION 2. The administrative heads of the several state colleges have for many years been known and referred to as "presidents", and the intent of this act is only to show the corresponding change in the statutes; no change in the status of the present incumbents is intended.
