CHAPTER 162

AN ACT relating to appropriating a sum of money from the general fund to persons named therein for payment of claims made by them against the state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the general fund \$83.25 to Donald Glynn to compensate him for damages to his automobile resulting from a collision with a Wisconsin national guard vehicle on May 1, 1960. Acceptance of this payment shall operate as a full and complete release to the state for any claim on account of such damages.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the general fund \$68.75 to Thomas L. Luecke to compensate him for damages to his automobile resulting from a collision with a Wisconsin national guard vehicle on June 28, 1960. Acceptance of this payment shall operate as a full and complete release to the state for any claim on account of such damages.

SECTION 3. There is appropriated from the general fund \$50 to Roy H. Wikstrom to compensate him for damages to his automobile resulting from a collision with a Wisconsin national guard vehicle on July 29, 1960. Acceptance of this payment shall operate as a full and complete release to the state for any claim on account of such damages.

SECTION 4. The claim of Eunice Anderson to compensate her for damages resulting from an accident at the university of Wisconsin on August 2, 1960, is allowed in the amount of \$61.44 and shall be paid from the appropriation made by section 20.830 (44) of the statutes. Acceptance of this payment shall operate as a full and complete release to the state for any claim on account of such damages.

SECTION 5. The claim of Robert C. Davis to compensate him for the loss of a raincoat in a cloak room in the Memorial Union at the university of Wisconsin on November 15, 1960 is allowed in the amount of \$25 and shall be paid from the appropriation made by section 20.830 (46) of the statutes. Acceptance of this payment shall operate as a full and complete release to the state for any claim on account of such damages.

SECTION 6. The claim of Mrs. Chris Graf to compensate her for damages caused by employes of the university while painting her apartment at University Houses on June 8, 1960 is allowed in the amount of \$25.09 and shall be paid from the appropriation made by section 20.830 (81) of the statutes. Acceptance of this payment shall operate as a full and complete release to the state for any claim on account of such damages.

SECTION 7. The claim of Mary Majerle to compensate her for damages during Easter vacation 1960 to a radio in her dormitory room at the uni-

versity of Wisconsin caused by the negligence of maintenance men employed by the university is allowed in the amount of \$10 and shall be paid from the appropriation made by section 20.830 (44) of the statutes. Acceptance of this payment shall operate as a full and complete release to the state for any claim on account of such damages.

SECTION 8. The claims of Stuart Matlins and E. Gordon Young to compensate them for damages resulting from the termination on March 15, 1960 of a theatre tour contract with the extension division of the University of Wisconsin are allowed in the amount of \$171 for each individual and the total of \$342 shall be paid from the 1960-61 appropriation made by section 20.830 (41) of the statutes. Acceptance of this payment shall operate as a full and complete release to the state for any claim on account of such damages.

SECTION 9. The claim of Jeanette Heinritz to compensate her for damages resulting from injuries suffered at the state fair grounds on August 22, 1959 is allowed in the amount of \$13.45 and shall be paid from the appropriation made by section 20.140 (61) of the statutes. Acceptance of this payment shall operate as a full and complete release to the state for any claim on account of such damages.
