CHAPTER 163

AN ACT to amend 66.28 of the statutes, relating to the extension of the authority to sell abandoned personal property to counties.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.28 of the statutes is amended to read:

66.28 SALE OF ABANDONED PROPERTY. Cities * * * , villages and counties may, at a public auction to be held once a year, dispose of any personal property which * * * has been abandoned, or * * * remained unclaimed for a period of 30 days after the taking of possession of the same by the city * * * , village or county officers. All receipts from such sales, after deducting the necessary expenses of keeping such property and conducting such auction, * * * is paid into the city * * * , village or county treasury.
