## CHAPTER 166

AN ACT to amend 160.07 (1) of the statutes, relating to fires caused by smoking in hotels, rooming and lodging houses and other places of public abode, and providing a penalty.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

160.07 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

160.07 (1) Any person who, by smoking, or attempting to light or to smoke cigarettes, cigars, pipes or tobacco, in any manner in which lighters or matches are employed, shall, in a careless, reckless or negligent manner, set fire to any bedding, furniture, curtains, drapes, house or any household fittings, or any part of any building specified in sub. (2), so as to endanger life or property in any way or to any extent, shall be fined not less than \* \* \* \$50 nor more than \* \* \* \$250, together with costs, \* \* \* or imprisoned not less than \* \* \* 10 days nor more than \* \* \* 6 months or both.
