CHAPTER 169

AN ACT to amend 959.15 (6) of the statutes, relating to court disposition of sex offenders.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

959.15 (6) of the statutes is amended to read:

959.15 (6) If it appears from said report that the department recommends specialized treatment for his mental or physical aberrations, the court shall order the proper county authorities to bring him before the court at county expense and shall either place him on probation under * * * ch. 57 with the requirement as a condition of such probation, that he receive outpatient *or inpatient* treatment in such manner as the court * * * *prescribes*, or commit him to the department under this section. If he is committed to the department the court shall order him conveyed by proper county authorities, at the expense of the county to the sex deviate facility, established by the department.
