CHAPTER 173

AN ACT to amend 48.34 (2) of the statutes, relating to juvenile court orders for supervision of children found delinquent.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

48.34 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

48.34 (2) All orders for supervision under sub. (1) (b) shall automatically terminate at the end of one year unless the court specifies a shorter or longer period in its order. But *before the order has expired* the court has continuing jurisdiction to renew * * * *the order* * * * *or make some other disposition of the case*, either on its own motion or that of any interested party, until the child reaches the age of 21.
