

## CHAPTER 203

AN ACT to amend 10.66 of the statutes, relating to the filing of papers, documents or affidavits pertaining to election matters with the board of election commissioners.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

10.66 of the statutes is amended to read:

10.66 The said board of election commissioners may procure a seal with which to authenticate official papers and documents and said board is authorized to employ such additional clerical assistants as \* \* \* is necessary \* \* \*, who shall receive such compensation as the county board \* \* \* determines. The county board shall arrange for office room for the said board of election commissioners; and all expenses incurred under ss. 10.63 to 10.70 shall be paid by the county. The act of a majority of said county board of election commissioners shall be considered the act of said board. *Whenever the statutes provide for the filing with the county clerk of any papers, documents or affidavits pertaining to election matters, the board of election commissioners shall be the proper agency in lieu of the county clerk.*
