**CHAPTER 207**

AN ACT to create 97.64 (3) of the statutes, relating to advertising turkeys according to grade.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

97.64 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

97.64 (3) No person, for himself, or as an agent, shall advertise at a stated price the sale of turkeys, which have been graded by the U. S. department of agriculture, unless the federal grade is set forth in such advertisement in not less than 10-point type.
