

**CHAPTER 216**

**AN ACT to amend 236.43 (intro. par.); and to create 236.43 (4) of the statutes, relating to revising the platting law.**

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

**SECTION 1. 236.43 (intro. par.) of the statutes is amended to read:**

**236.43 (intro. par.) VACATION OR ALTERATION OF AREAS DEDICATED TO THE PUBLIC.** Parts of a plat dedicated to and accepted by the public for public use may be vacated *or altered* as follows:

**SECTION 2. 236.43 (4) of the statutes is created to read:**

**236.43 (4)** When the plat is being vacated or altered in any city of the second, third or fourth class or in any incorporated village or town which includes a street, alley or public walkway, said street, alley or public walkway may be vacated or altered by the circuit court proceeding under ss. 236.41 and 236.42 upon the following conditions:

(a) A resolution is passed by the governing body requesting such vacation or alteration.

(b) The owners of all frontage of the lots and lands abutting on the portion sought to be vacated or altered request in writing that such action be taken.
