**CHAPTER 229**

**AN ACT to amend 151.03 of the statutes, relating to permits to dispense drugs and medicines in rural districts.**

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

151.03 of the statutes is amended to read:

151.03 In rural districts with no registered pharmacist or assistant pharmacist within 3 miles, the board may issue \* \* \* a permit to sell on certain premises for one year, drugs and medicines specified therein, upon payment of the fee fixed by the board, not exceeding \$10. *The premises for which the permit is issued must be an establishment where merchandise is sold and shall be specified in the permit.* An applicant for a permit for a new rural store or for a permit upon change of ownership of an existing rural store shall pay an inspection fee of \$15 in addition to the annual permit fee of \$10.
