

CHAPTER 245

AN ACT to amend 940.20 of the statutes, relating to consent being a defense in battery cases.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

940.20 of the statutes is amended to read:

940.20 Whoever causes bodily harm to another by an act done with intent to cause bodily harm to that person or another *without the consent of the person so harmed* may be fined not more than \$200 or imprisoned not more than 6 months or both.
