## CHAPTER 248

AN ACT to create 943.45 of the statutes, relating to obtaining telecommunications services by fraud, and providing a penalty.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

943.45 of the statutes is created to read:

943.45 OBTAINING TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE BY FRAUD. Whoever with intent to defraud obtains or attempts to obtain telecommunications service by any of the following means may be fined not more than \$100 or imprisoned not more than 30 days, or both:

(1) Charging such service to an existing telephone number or credit card number without the consent of the subscriber thereto or the legitimate holder thereof.

(2) Charging such service to a false, fictitious, suspended, terminated, expired, canceled or revoked telephone number or credit card number.
