CHAPTER 251

AN ACT to amend 139.50 (3) (e); and to create 139.50 (3) (g) of the statutes, relating to filing of a bond to guarantee payment of tobacco taxes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 139.50 (3) (e) of the statutes is amended to read:

139.50 (3) (e) In lieu of stamps the commissioner may permit the use of meter machines and where used a $3\frac{3}{4}$ per cent discount on the total tax due shall be allowed. Such machines shall be used under * * * rules prescribed by the commissioner of taxation * * * .

SECTION 2. 139.50 (3) (g) of the statutes is created to read:

139.50 (3) (g) Permittees shall be entitled to purchase tobacco tax stamps and tobacco tax meter settings on credit upon filing a payment guarantee bond in a suitable amount as the commissioner requires.
