CHAPTER 258

AN ACT to amend section 28 of chapter 315, laws of 1959, relating to the time of abolishing a small claims court for La Crosse county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 315, laws of 1959, section 28, is amended to read:

(Chapter 315, laws of 1959) Section 28. All other statutory courts except the county courts and except any small claims court for La Crosse county, are abolished effective the first Monday in January 1962. Any small claims court for La Crosse county is abolished effective on the first Monday in May 1962. All actions, proceedings and other matters pending in those courts on December 31, 1961, and in any small claims court for La Crosse county on May 5, 1962 which are within the jurisdiction of the county court under sections 253.10 to 253.14 of the statutes as created by this act are transferred to the county court. All actions, proceedings and

other matters not within such jurisdiction are transferred to the circuit court. All records and files of statutory courts which are abolished shall be transmitted to the clerk of circuit court.

SECTION 2. The small claims court of La Crosse county shall continue to May 5, 1962, pursuant to chapter 609, laws of 1955, and, whether repealed or not, the provisions of chapter 254 of the statutes as printed in the 1959 statutes.
