CHAPTER 259

AN ACT authorizing the state department of public welfare to sell and convey portions of the state-owned lands connected with the central Wisconsin colony and training school, and crediting the proceeds therefrom to state building trust funds, and authorizing said department to expend therefrom amounts for payment of the expenses of such sale.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

The director of the state department of public welfare, with the approval of the governor, is authorized to sell and convey those portions of the state-owned lands which are now a part of the premises of the central Wisconsin colony and training school which lie northeast of state trunk highway 113 containing 4.3 acres, and between state trunk highway 113 and the Chicago & Northwestern Railroad right of way containing 8.6 acres, under such terms, conditions and covenants as the director shall determine. The state department of public welfare is authorized to pay the expenses of such sale or sales out of the proceeds thereof. The balance shall be deposited in the state building trust fund.
