CHAPTER 274

AN ACT to create 40.303 of the statutes, relating to the approval of school construction in nonhigh school area.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

40.303 of the statutes is created to read:

40.303 APPROVAL OF SCHOOL PLANTS. Until July 30, 1962, the school board of any school district, any part of which is not a part of a school district operating a high school, shall not incur an indebtedness for the acquisition of property for a school site, for the erection of a new school building or for an addition to an existing building without prior approval of the state superintendent of public instruction or the school board of the district providing high school education to the majority of the students in such school district.
