CHAPTER 288

AN ACT to create 66.054 (8a) (i) and 176.17 (5a) of the statutes, relating to prohibiting accumulated discounts for certain licensees.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 66.054 (8a) (i) of the statutes is created to read:

66.054 (8a) (i) Volume discounts to class "A" licensees are prohibited when these discounts, rebates or refunds are based upon the licensees purchases from a manufacturer, rectifier or wholesaler over a period of time on a series of transactions. Discounts are permissible only when based upon a quantity of the product purchased in a single transaction, a single delivery and a single invoice. Such permissible discounts shall be available to all class "A" licensees.

SECTION 2. 176.17 (5a) of the statutes is created to read:

176.17 (5a) Volume discounts to "Class A" licensees are prohibited when these discounts, rebates or refunds are based upon the licensees purchases from a manufacturer, rectifier or wholesaler over a period of time on a series of transactions. Discounts are permissible only when based upon a quantity of the product purchased in a single transaction, a single delivery and a single invoice. Such permissible discounts shall be available to all "Class A" licensees.
