CHAPTER 3

AN ACT relating to jurisdiction of police justice of the peace within the jurisdiction of the municipal court for the eastern and western districts of Waukesha county.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Notwithstanding any other provision of the acts creating the municipal courts for the eastern and western districts for Waukesha county, a police justice of the peace, in any city in the district (except the cities of Waukesha and Oconomowoc) or if there is no police justice then a justice of the peace in such city, shall have concurrent jurisdiction with the said municipal judge over ordinance violations occurring in the city where the said justice holds office. The said jurisdiction of such police justice, or justice of the peace, shall terminate as of the effective date of the court reorganization act (Chapter 315 of the Laws of 1959), i.e., January 1, 1962, and shall thereafter be placed and exercised as provided in said chapter 315. All judgments rendered prior to January 1, 1961, in such ordinance violation cases by the said police justice of the peace or, if there were no police justice then by a justice of the peace, in any city in the eastern district of Waukesha county, except in the city of Waukesha, which have not been reversed for lack of jurisdiction, are hereby validated.
