CHAPTER 331

AN ACT to repeal section 23 of chapter 226, laws of 1959; and to create 262.025 and 992.16 of the statutes, relating to the method of commencing civil actions, and validating the method used in commencing such actions after chapter 226, laws of 1959.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 262.025 of the statutes is created to read:

262.025 STATUTES APPLICABLE. After the effective date (1961) of this section, civil actions shall be commenced as provided in this chapter.

SECTION 2. 992.16 of the statutes is created to read:

992.16 VALIDATION OF METHOD OF COMMENCEMENT OF CERTAIN CIVIL ACTIONS. The commencement of civil actions between July

1, 1960, and the effective date of this section (1961), whether under the procedure of ch. 262 (as created by chapter 226, laws of 1959) or under the procedure of chapter 262 of the statutes as it existed prior to July 1, 1960, is hereby validated regardless of when the cause of action arose.

SECTION 3. Chapter 226, laws of 1959, section 23, is repealed.
