CHAPTER 393

AN ACT to create 347.26 (9) of the statutes, relating to warning lamps on public utility vehicles.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

347.26 (9) of the statutes is created to read:

347.26 (9) Warning lamps on public utility vehicles. Any vehicle of a public utility as defined in s. 196.01 (1) which by reason of its use upon a highway creates a vehicular traffic hazard requiring the exercise of unusual care in approaching, overtaking or passing may be equipped with a flashing amber lamp of the dome type or with 2 flashing amber lamps, one showing to the front and one showing to the rear. Such lamps shall be mounted approximately midway between the extremities of the width of the vehicle and at the highest practicable point and shall be used only for the purpose of warning operators of other vehicles of the presence of the traffic hazard.
