## CHAPTER 413

AN ACT to create 20.280 (88) of the statutes, to appropriate \$10,000 from the conservation fund to the board of regents of the university for making an engineering study and survey to determine the cost of acquisition of lands and the construction and development of an artificial lake on Billings Creek of certain lands in Vernon county as an addition to and extension of Wildcat Mountain state park and the feasibility of such terrain for the purpose, and report the result thereof to the legislature.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

20.280 (88) of the statutes is created to read:

20.280 (88) WILDCAT MOUNTAIN SURVEY. There is appropriated \$10,000 from the conservation fund to the regents of the university with which to make an engineering study and survey to determine the cost of the acquisition of lands for and the construction and development of an artificial lake on Billings Creek as an addition to and extension of Wildcat Mountain state park, Vernon county, and the feasibility of the terrain for the purpose, such lands lying in township 14 north, range 1 west, and township 14, range 2 west. The regents shall cause to be furnished as much assistance as possible and practicable from pertinent faculty members and employ private qualified consulting engineers. The regents shall report the result of such investigation, study and survey to the legislature as soon as possible after the completion thereof.
