CHAPTER 42

AN ACT to amend 160.01 (3) of the statutes, relating to the definition of public health and safety.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

160.01 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

160.01 (3) "Public health and safety" means the highest degree of protection against infection, *contagion * * ** or disease and freedom from the danger of fire or accident that a hotel or restaurant or tourist rooming house will reasonably permit.
