CHAPTER 430

AN ACT to create 110.07 (2m) of the statutes, relating to the powers of the state traffic patrol.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

110.07 (2m) of the statutes is created to read:

110.07 (2m) In addition to the primary powers granted by subs. (1) and (2), any officer of the state traffic patrol who is in uniform and on duty may arrest without warrant any person who commits a misdemeanor or a felony on the highway in his presence, or who is transporting a stolen motor vehicle or who is fleeing from the scene of a crime or from other law enforcement officers and deliver him to the sheriff or police chief in the jurisdiction where the arrest is made. A state traffic officer making an arrest pursuant to this subsection shall at all times be available as a witness for the state.
