CHAPTER 442

AN ACT to amend 59.15 (3) of the statutes, relating to the reimbursement for expense of officials and employes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

59.15 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

59.15 (3) The board may provide for reimbursement to any elective officer, deputy officer, appointive officer or employe of any expense out-of-pocket incurred in the discharge of his duty in addition to his salary or compensation, including without limitation because of enumeration, traveling expenses within or without the county or state, *tuition costs incurred in attending courses of instruction clearly related to his employment*, and the board may establish standard allowances for mileage, room and meals, the purposes for which such allowances may be made, and determine the reasonableness and necessity for such reimbursements, and also establish in advance a fair rate of compensation to be paid to the sheriff for the board and care of prisoners in the county jail at county expense.
