

CHAPTER 514

AN ACT to create chapter 423, laws of 1923, section 1 (71) thereby amending chapter 423, laws of 1923, section 1 (69), relating to authority of cities of the first class to increase retirement benefits for Milwaukee city firemen.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Chapter 423, laws of 1923, section 1 (71) is created to read:

(Chapter 423, Laws of 1923) Section 1. (71) Notwithstanding any other provision contained in this chapter, and notwithstanding any other statute, and commencing on the effective date (1961) of this subsection, every city of the first class may increase the annuities and other benefits provided in chapter 423, laws of 1923, as amended, for all firemen who have retired from active service and who shall have attained the age of 65 years, and for all widows who shall have attained the age of 62 years, and for children under 18 years of age who are entitled to benefits from the fund, provided that such increase of annuities and other benefits shall be based upon amended contract between such city and such retired firemen and by or for such other beneficiaries.
