**CHAPTER 573**

AN ACT to amend 59.03 (1) (c); and to create 66.196 of the statutes, relating to the authority to increase the salary of any elective county, city, village or town official during his term.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 59.03 (1) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

59.03 (1) (c) Each supervisor shall be paid by the county an annual salary which shall be set by the county board. The board may provide additional compensation for the chairman. The salaries of supervisors in effect on June 21, \* \* \* 1961 shall remain the annual salary until changed by action of the board. *Section 69.196 also applies to this paragraph.*

SECTION 2. 66.196 of the statutes is created to read:

66.196 COMPENSATION OF GOVERNING BODIES. An elected official of any county, city, town or village who by virtue of his office is entitled to participate in the establishment of the salary attending his office, shall not during the term of such office collect salary in excess of the salary provided at the time of his taking office. This provision is of state-wide concern and applies only to officials elected after the effective date of this section (1961).
