CHAPTER 575

AN ACT to amend 66.195 of the statutes, relating to emergency salary adjustments for elected officials.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.195 of the statutes is amended to read:

66.195 During the period commencing February 27, 1951, and ending December 31, * * * 1963, the governing body of any county, city, village or town may, during the term of office of any elected official whose salary is paid in whole or in part by such county, city, village or town, increase the salary of such elected official in such amount as the governing body may determine. The power granted by this section shall take effect notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, except that the exercise of such power shall be governed by s. 65.90 (5). *The power granted by this section shall not extend to elected officials who by virtue of their office are entitled to participate in the establishment of the compensation attending their office.*
