**CHAPTER 66**

**AN ACT to create 30.90 of the statutes, relating to public access to lake Lions in Portage county.**

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

30.90 of the statutes is created to read:

**30.90 PUBLIC ACCESS TO LAKE LIONS.** Neither the county or town, may provide, nor shall any subdivider be required or permitted to provide, public access to Lions lake in the town of Alban, Portage county, if such public access will in any way interfere with the use of the lake as a recreational area for the physically handicapped as long as such use is continued. The conservation commission may stock said lake with fish as long as such use is continued, any provision in ch. 29 to the contrary notwithstanding. The town board of the town of Alban shall have jurisdiction over lake Lions, and may enact and enforce such ordinances necessary to prevent any deterioration of the said waters or any nuisances which would adversely affect the health or safety of the people.
