CHAPTER 673

AN ACT to repeal 253.13 (2) (f), as created by chapter 495, laws of 1961; and to create 59.23 (12) of the statutes, relating to the assignment of deputy sheriffs to the county court.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 59.23 (12) of the statutes is created to read:

59.23 (12) In counties having a population of 500,000 or more, the sheriff shall upon request of any county judge assign deputy sheriffs to the county court, who shall be designated as deputy sheriffs of the county court, and each of whom shall receive the same salary as is paid to other deputy sheriffs of the county. Such deputy sheriffs shall act as attendants upon said county court during its sessions. The judges of said county court may make rules to be entered in full upon the records of said court, concerning the attendance and duties of such deputy sheriffs as the judges of said county court deem proper, and it is the duty of such deputy sheriffs to conform to the same.

SECTION 2. 253.13 (2) (f) of the statutes, as created by chapter 495, laws of 1961, is repealed.
