CHAPTER 679

AN ACT to repeal 3.13 and 4.05; to amend 3.08, 4.01 (second paragraph) and 4.02 (paragraph specifying the twenty-ninth senatorial district); and to create 4.01 (a paragraph preceding the paragraph headed "Brown County"), relating to constituting the counties of Menominee and Shawano as an assembly district, and the counties of Marathon, Menominee and Shawano as the twenty-ninth senatorial district, and adding Menominee county to the seventh congressional district, due to the creation of Menominee county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 3.08 of the statutes is amended to read:

3.08 The counties of Adams, Green Lake, Langlade, Marathon, Marquette, Menominee, Portage, Shawano, Waupaca, Waushara and Wood constitute the seventh district.

SECTION 2. 3.13 of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 3. 4.01 (second paragraph) of the statutes is amended to read:

4.01 (second paragraph) The counties of Barron, Calumet, Chippewa, Clark, Columbia, Dunn, Grant, Green, Jefferson, Lincoln, Marinette, Monroe, Oconto, Ozaukee, Portage, St. Croix, Sauk, * * * Vernon, Walworth, Washington and Waupaca shall each constitute an assembly district.

SECTION 4. 4.01 (paragraph preceding the paragraph headed "Brown County") of the statutes is created to read:

4.01 (paragraph preceding paragraph headed "Brown County") The counties of Menominee and Shawano shall constitute an assembly district.

SECTION 5. 4.02 (paragraph specifying the twenty-ninth senatorial district) of the statutes is amended to read:

4.02 (paragraph specifying the twenty-ninth senatorial district) The counties of Marathon, *Menominee* and Shawano shall constitute the twenty-ninth district.

SECTION 6. 4.05 of the statutes is repealed.
